ATR VERDICT: The application of a tongue-tie and blinkers could make the difference with VAZZY who showed ability here towards the end of last year. The Tagula gelding was a close third when last seen here in November and probably doesn't need to improve much to win a race of this standard. The booking of Colin Keane is obviously an eye-catcher. Ablah has been knocking on the door and despite a 3lb rise for her latest placed effort at Naas she should be a big player. Stop On Red is another who has been fine form and could get involved at the finish.

ATR VERDICT: A strong looking handicap and the progressive ALHAAZM may be able to strike again despite an 8lb rise for his win here last month. The full-brother to Awtaad has really blossomed since joining Kevin Prendergast and won nicely on his return. The handicapper gave him plenty for that success but it may be worth following him giving his recent improvement. Major Power is a five time course and distance winner and was probably value for a bit more than his winning margin last time. He looks an obvious danger. His trainer Eddie Lynam is also represented by another last time out winner Sister Lola. She is also a course and distance winner but may have enough weight now after a 7lb rise for winning at Gowran last time.

ATR VERDICT: TITLE finished his race really well on debut here, getting within a neck of success over that mile trip. The ground is much quicker for his return, but Roger Varian's son of Camelot is likely to relish this test of stamina and can open his account. Alpine Stroll was too keen for his own good on his return at Doncaster but still ran well enough for fourth to be a contender in this, especially if that race has taken some of the freshness off him. Vino Victrix ran well for second on both starts as a juvenile and is bred to relish this longer trip, while John Gosden's Glen Savage and the William Haggas-trained Into The Fire look the pick of the newcomers.
