


**ATR VERDICT:** The Cullentra House team have won three of the last five in this valuable sales race and NONBINDING may add to that impressive recent record. **ATR VERDICT:** LOTTIE MARIE wasn't a surprise winner at Wolverhampton because she really has the bit between her teeth at the moment and has held her form admirably since scoring at Chelmsford in December.
