ATR VERDICT: SIRJACK THOMAS was a brilliant winner of the Colin Quinn BMW Mile on Tuesday and he will be well fancied to follow up. Successful at 25/1 and 50/1 on his last two starts, the son of Fast Company will be a lot shorter now. Upped 10lb for his three-length success on Tuesday, he carries just a 7lb winners penalty here. Adrian McGuinness trains the selection and he is also represented by Current Option, winner of this race 12 months ago, Laugh A Minute and Spanish Tenor. The latter went off fast on Tuesday and set it up perfectly for the selection, so it'll be interesting to see if similar tactics are deployed. Stone Solider and On A Session make the journey across the Irish Sea and they both warrant respect, while Hightimeyouwon, Soaring Monarch, Quizical and Lust are other leading contenders.




ATR VERDICT: MICRO MANAGE can make a winning return to the Flat. He was placed in a couple of maiden hurdles at Leopardstown and Naas in December and January respectively, but was formerly a classy sort on the level as a mark of 104 would indicate. He last ran in this sphere when unplaced in the Group 1 Irish St Leger in September, and was Group-3 placed on his penultimate start. He holds that same Group 3 entry for August. Mythical was last seen finishing in rear of a Group 2 in October in France and has been keeping very good company. He has since moved from Aidan O'Brien to Joseph O'Brien and should enjoy this assignment on his return. He has the same Group 3 entry. Monas Melody was strong off the front in a qualified riders' maiden in Killarney and could get into a good rhythm here.
