ATR VERDICT: Watashock ran well when third at Newcastle on his UK debut, but got bogged down on heavy going when eighth at Huntingdon. With his yard in good form, he can go close on this better ground over hurdles and may be a danger to all. However, preference is for REWIRED, who was second in a better race at Kempton in December and again last time out at Doncaster, so he ought to find this company far easier to deal with. Norman Kindu won on the Flat at Wetherby and is one to watch on his hurdling debut.

ATR VERDICT: STOKES was a close-up second at Sedgefield on his handicap debut and can reward connections here as he steps up in trip. The winner that day turned in a good display next time to give the form a solid look, and natural progression should help Ben Pauling's charge get his head in front. Thelasthighking makes his handicap debut and may confirm some of his early promise, while Confirmation Bias reverts to hurdling after pulling up on his chasing debut.

ATR VERDICT: Fil Dor has long been regarded as Gordon Elliott's main hope for this race, but he was comfortably held at Leopardstown by Vauban, who was narrowly beaten by PIED PIPER at Punchestown in late December. Vauban and Pied Piper have certainly improved since that clash and both demand respect, but the latter was so impressive when winning at this track last time and that makes him look the slightly more solid of the pair. Il Etait Temps ran a cracker when third in the aforementioned Leopardstown contest and he's no back number, nor is his stablemate Icare Allen, although he needs to brush up on his jumping. Knight Salute is five from five over timber and looks best of the home team.

ATR VERDICT: If COOLE WELL gives his running then it is difficult to look anywhere else for the winner. He is well-in at the weights on official ratings as well and should prove too good for the unexposed Scudamore, who has finished third and fourth over hurdles so far and is open to improvement.
