ATR VERDICT: STEEL WAVE is a 12-year-old now but he is in flying form. In his last four starts, Gary Hanmers' gelding has recorded a victory at Ludlow and three placed efforts and, while there are younger legs to contend with once more, he can get his head in front. Head On is three from five over the larger obstacles (pulled up on the other two occasions) and is a threat to all if he puts his best foot forward, while Percussion has been fairly consistent and can make his presence felt.


