**ATR VERDICT:** A tricky opener with most of the higher rated runners struggling to find their form. SCARPETA won three times over hurdles for Willie Mullins with a career high rating of 151. A reproduction of his second to Darasso at Killarney last May would easily be good enough here but his form has fallen off a cliff since. In his defence a number of those runs were over fences where he didn't jump well but his latest run over hurdles here in December was very disappointing. Fire Squadron and Buzz Light haven't been disgraced in handicaps and could pick up the pieces if the selection disappoints again, while Spare Brakes has generally been campaigned over fences of late but did win a claiming hurdle on his penultimate start at Limerick.

**ATR VERDICT:** MISE RAFTAIRE has run a couple of solid races recently and should be good enough to land a race of this standard. The Dylan Thomas gelding was third on his penultimate start at Punchestown and the runner-up Wild Hunt has scored twice since. Last time out the selection weakened late on when fourth to Missiee in Gowran and dropping back in trip now could help. 
