ATR VERDICT: PARISENCORE has found just one rival too strong on each of his four starts over obstacles and this looks like the perfect opportunity to get off the mark. The six-year-old has shown plenty of promise and gets the nod to land the spoils, while Cartonne has been largely consistent of late and rates the most immediate danger. Chase Outlaw has failed to fire in two hurdles starts so far but the point-to-point winner but may be able to take a step forward.

ATR VERDICT: In this competitive contest marginal preference is for the in-form BRIEF AMBITION, who arrives on the hunt for a hat-trick of wins. Despite a lengthy layoff, the Fergal O'Brien-trained gelding remains unbeaten over the larger obstacles and a mark of 128 may underestimate his ability. Burrows Diamond has been given an 8lb rise after romping home at Uttoxeter and demands plenty of respect, while Nero Rock is another to consider.




ATR VERDICT: HAPPY DU MESNIL stayed on when third over 2m at Sandown earlier in the month on his first start for Evan Williams and this appears to be the ideal opportunity for him to gain a first career success as he steps up in trip. Pay The Pilot was runner-up on his bumper debut at Punchestown last March and was bought subsequently for 130,000 pounds at the Cheltenham sale at the end of that month, while Realm Of Glory is open to improvement following his hurdles debut at Chepstow.

ATR VERDICT: The value may lie with last year's winner CHEF D'OEUVRE, who arrives here 7lb lower than 12 months ago for his in-form connections. The 11-year-old hasn't cut much ice this season, but his second at Wetherby on his penultimate start is cause for optimism, as well as his record at this track. Tim Pat will be fancied by many to land the hat-trick following a comfortable success at Carlisle, but he has yet to try this far, while Generator City is an intriguing recruit to the Ian Williams stable.

ATR VERDICT: ROSEARELLI went up 4lb for winning on her chase debut at Market Rasen last month, having run in maiden hurdles in the autumn, and Ali Stronge's mare appears capable of stepping forward from that performance. ATR VERDICT: D'JANGO has shown steady improvement since joining the David Pipe stable and the nine-year-old must hold every chance here if building upon a strong runner-up effort at Wincanton earlier in the month. Dynamite Kentucky has run creditably since a brace of victories in January, while Shah An Shah has been knocking on the door of late, having finished second on his last two outings. ATR VERDICT: Both owner Tim Syder and trainer Richard Bandey have been having a fine run of late and GODREY POINT can keep the ball rolling. Runner-up to the talented Skytastic on his penultimate start and a winner since at Hereford, the son of Coastal Path could be potentially thrown in off a mark of 117 on his handicap debut. Unlike the selection, River Walk is not proven over this distance and must improve upon an underwhelming effort at Musselburgh, while Turning Gold is a player based on the pick of his form.

ATR VERDICT: The form of VALSHEDA's most recent second at Kempton has been well franked by the winner and the fourth going in since, and this represents an ideal opportunity for the son of Milan to get off the mark over fences. Jaytee impressed at Taunton last time out, but a 9lb rise for that success and forecast drier conditions may halt his progress on this occasion. Shaman Du Berlais was unlucky not to get his head in front at Haydock last month and the step up in trip could eke out further improvement here.
