ATR VERDICT: CASHEW lurks on a very tempting mark and having shown a bit more at Lingfield last time, she might be ready to strike, with Connor Planas' 7lb claim only enhancing her appeal. Cherish has finished second on her last two starts at Windsor over 5f and the extra furlong here could be very much in her favour. Grand Cru Gaga won in impressive style at Ffos Las last month and she's worth considering on her handicap debut.
